



Voting Guidelines

Voting Procedures

Adapted from page 20 & 21 of the NIA20 Service Manual

- Simple majority for typical business.
- Two-thirds majority for guideline changes.
- At the discretion of the District Committee Member or request by any member, a sense of the assembly whether to advise to table, revise, or move forward with a vote may be taken for specific issues.

Voting Members

Adapted from page 17 of the NIA20 Service Manual

- All current District 43 AA Group G.S.R.s **or** Alternate, when G.S.R. is absent
- District Committee Member (DCM) **and** Alt. District Committee Member
- The District 43 Secretary **and** Alternate Secretary
- All District 43 Standing Committee Chairpersons **or** Alternate, when Chairperson is absent
- The District 43 Treasurer **and** Alternate Treasurer

Zoom / Online Voting Process

Adapted from the Technology in AA Forum

- All voting members, as outlined by their guidelines, must change their name to reflect the service position in which they are voting for.
- Count is taken of all voting members prior to launch of poll.
- Poll is launched and votes are cast.
- If number of votes tallied is less than or equal to the number of voters present the vote is accepted as valid.

**In the event that a valid vote cannot be attained after multiple attempts the following voting guidelines may be used:*

- All voting members, as outlined by their guidelines, must change their name to reflect the service position in which they are voting for.
- A predetermined facilitator poses the question "all in favor of approving the proposed motion please raise your hand using the participants screen"
- The votes are counted and recorded.
- The facilitator poses the question "all opposed of approving the proposed motion please raise your hand using the participants screen"
- The votes are counted and recorded.
